


Address Look Up


ADDRESS LOOKUP

This is a required action to complete the application.

Start with the House Number and then tab to the Direction text box and then to the Street Name text box.

Enter just the name of the street, don't worry about using "Blvd", "Ln", "St", etc.

Click on the "Address Lookup" button.

Assessor's Data

If you get a match from the assessor's database, then the window (pictured above) will open and will present various data about the property as well as the name of the inspector assigned to the area.

When this window opens up simply click on the 'Close' button and continue with your application.

Ownership information will be imported into your application.

Finding Your Address in the Assessor's Database

If the address and street name do not exactly match the assessor's information, then the windows pictured below will open.

If the number or street name (more commonly) don't match then you may have to select the appropriate one as shown below.

If you mistyped or don't have the correct number, you can select from the range of addresses on the street by clicking on the blue 'Handle' link.


Clicking on the 'Handle' link will import the ownership information into the application.

If You Don't Find Your Address in the Assessor's Database

If you are unable to find your address in the assessor's database, then you can check on the '**Address Not Found**' box.

This box will appear only after an attempt has been made to search the assessor's data.

By checking this box you will be notifying Building Division supervisors that your address was not able to be found.
